

Student Technology Agreement

The use of technology can be valuable for a student's education. Use of school-owned technology and school Internet access is a privilege, which may be authorized as well as withdrawn at the school's discretion. Students are expected to be aware of all standards set forth in *[policy number TBD ELECTRONIC INFORMATION RESOURCES AND ACCEPTABLE USE]*, including the following:

1. Student Personal Safety

Personal contact information may not be entered on Internet sites open to public access. This includes student address, phone numbers, personal e-mail addresses and other personal information.

2. Expectation of Privacy

Students do not have an expectation of privacy in files, disks, documents, e-mail, etc., which have been accessed, used or created with school equipment.

3. Prohibited Computer and Device Uses – Students are prohibited from (but not limited to):

- Accessing, storing or creating offensive, profane, or pornographic files/software/applications
- Plagiarizing works or violating copyrights or trademarks
- Damaging, altering, or modifying school owned hardware or software
- Attempting to bypass computer security, including monitoring systems, web filters and malware detection software
- Loading and running programs from removable media
- Downloading and using non-approved software
- Harming, defaming, harassing, or otherwise cyber-bullying ANY individual
- Unauthorized use during class time.

4. Internet Use

Students will require internet access for many classroom activities. This use is by permission of Bonneville Academy administration. This privilege may be revoked at the discretion of school staff.

5. Disciplinary Actions

Disciplinary actions will be taken pursuant to this agreement (e.g. loss of access to equipment, suspension, law enforcement involvement, etc.) as set forth by *[policy number TBD ELECTRONIC INFORMATION RESOURCES AND ACCEPTABLE USE]*.
