SCHOOL LAND TRUST PROGRAM SY2021-22

he School LAND Trust Program, established by the Legislature in 1999, distributes a portion of the earnings from the permanent State School Fund through school districts and charter schools for all public schools in the state. In charter schools, elected parents and educators, along with the school principal, serve on a School Community Council. Charter schools have Trust Land Councils with similar membership. In every school, these councils review school-wide assessment data and prepare a plan to address the school's most critical academic need(s). Local Boards approve the plans, and funding is sent to each school with an approved plan before the traditional school year begins. IMPROVE STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT IN MATH FOR ALL GRADES BY 3%

GOAL 1 - The council decided that improving student academic performance in Math was paramount to the continued success of our students. A math specialist and two math tutors were hired and math manipulatives were purchased, along with extra Chromebooks that allowed students in lower grades better access to Imagine Math, our math curriculum. Yearend RISE testing results confirm an 8% average increase in all grades measured.

IMPROVE SCIENCE SCORES FOR K-5 BY 3%

GOAL 2 - To increase student achievement in Science for grades K-5 by the end of academic year 2022 and provide teachers with access to standards-based curriculum. Bonneville Academy purchased Open Educational Resource (OER) Science Textbooks for use in the classroom to provide learning based around the new SEED standards. Year-end RISE testing results show an 11% average increase for all grades measured.

IMPROVE ACHIEVEMENT IN ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS ACROSS K-5

GOAL 3 - To improve student achievement in English Language Arts for grades K-5 during the 2021-22 school year by 3%, as measured in RISE. Bonneville Academy hired two Language Arts tutors to work directly with struggling students. Year-end RISE testing results show an 11% average increase for all grades measured.
