Student Dress Code

Bonneville Academy's dress code was created to help the school maintain a fun, dynamic, and consistent environment while reaping the benefits of improved behavior, increased security, and reduced disciplinary issues. The Board of Directors does not wish to impose an additional burden on families by mandating specific clothing from a list of preferred providers. We reserve the right to make changes to this dress code policy as necessary. Students are expected to dress modestly, maintain a clean, orderly, and neat appearance, and practice good grooming and personal hygiene habits.

The following items are NOT allowed:

Tops:

- NO Neon colors
- NO Hoods may be worn in the building
- NO Tank tops or midriff

Bottoms:

- NO Shorts, skirts, or dresses more than 2" above the knee.
- NO Ill-fitting bottoms (cannot be too tight or too loose)
- NO Leggings or jeggings without bottom completely covered by tunic top, shorts, or skirt.

General:

- NO Bizarre, extreme, or unusual hairstyles unless approved by administration ●
- NO Open-toed or open-heeled shoes (entire foot must be covered)
- NO Wheelie shoes
- NO Clothes and accessories that may be disruptive or cause security issues
- NO Tears, fraying, holes, or distressed clothing
- NO Hair accessories that are distracting or exceed 2" in diameter
- NO Clothing featuring advertising, promotions, or depictions related to tobacco, e-cigarettes, alcohol, gang activity or association, or drugs is permitted, nor is clothing that contradicts the educational mission
- NO Clothing with writing, pictures, or any other insignias, which are crude, vulgar, profane, violent, or sexually suggestive, or promote illegal/criminal activity
- NO Exposed undergarments
- NO Gauges
- NO Chains
- NO Hats
