Cloth Face Mask Face

Students, employees and visitors will be required to wear masks during the school day. Case by case accommodations may be made



Handwashing and Sanitizing

Bonneville Academy will increase instruction and monitoring of student handwashing. We will have freestanding hand sanitizing stations positioned throughout the school



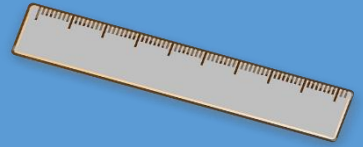
Entry/Exit Procedures

Carpools will be met at the curb by staff. Temperatures will be taken and screening questions will be asked. If screening is not successful, students will return home with carpool. Walkers will participate in the same screening. Each morning all staff will be asked to participate in screenings.



No Physical Contact/Physical Distancing

The rule of thumb is to maintain 6 feet of distance between yourself and anyone else. Students and staff will be reminded to practice physical distancing when it comes to greetings — no handshakes, high fives or hugs. Air high fives, air elbow bumps or a simple wave can be used in place of physical contact.



Training

All staff will receive training on protocols for reopening, containing outbreaks, monitoring staff and student symptoms. Strategies to mitigate risk. Training will also be given for protocol for reclosing.

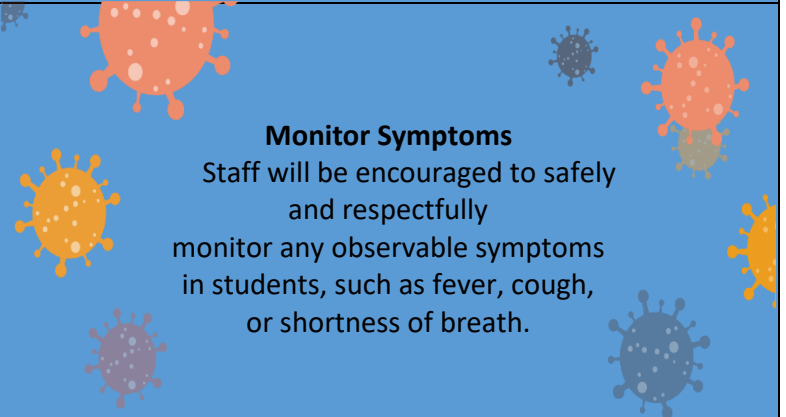
Illness Rooms

If a student begins exhibiting symptoms after arriving at school, they will wait in the illness room with a facial mask and maintain physical distancing while arrangements are made for them to be picked up by a parent or emergency contact as soon as possible.



Clean & Disinfecting Cleaning Schedule

Bonneville Academy will implement a multi-step cleaning protocol, to include daily disinfection of touchpoints. Each evening the entire school will be disinfected using electrostatic foggers.



Monitor Symptoms

Staff will be encouraged to safely and respectfully monitor any observable symptoms in students, such as fever, cough, or shortness of breath.
