

Dual Enrollment Policy

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The purpose of this policy is to state Bonneville Academy's position on the dual enrollment of private school and home schooled students in the school. Utah Code states that students may be dually enrolled in both the school and in a private school or home school under the conditions stated below:

A parent seeking to dually enroll a student must certify that the student will receive instruction in the subjects the State Board of Education requires to be taught in public schools and for the same length of time as required in public schools, as provided by the rules of the State Board of Education.

All students at Bonneville Academy must be enrolled in the school for at least $\frac{3}{4}$ of each school day. Therefore, no student of Bonneville Academy will be allowed to dually enroll if they do not plan to attend at least $\frac{3}{4}$ of each school day.

Requests for dual enrollment should be provided to the School Director. Students who are dually enrolled at Bonneville Academy, and in a private school or home school will only take the State Tests and other assessments for the subjects for which they received instruction from Bonneville Academy.
