Dress Code

Bonneville Academy's dress code was created to assist the school have a fun, dynamic, consistent environment while enjoying the benefits of a uniform including improved behavior, increased security and fewer disciplinary issues. The Board of Directors does not want to put an extra burden on families by requiring students to wear specific clothing from a list of preferred providers. We reserve the right to make changes to this dress code policy as needed.

Students shall dress modestly, maintain a clean, orderly, and neat appearance, and exercise good grooming and personal hygiene habits.

The following items are NOT allowed:

Tops:

NO Neon colors

NO Advertisements, pictures, graphic designs, or other logos. (larger than a quarter)

NO Hoods may be worn in the building

NO Tank tops or midriff

Bottoms:

NO Shorts, skirts, or dresses more than 2" above knee.

NO Ill-fitting bottoms (cannot be too tight or too loose)

NO Advertisements, **pictures, graphic designs**, or other logos. (larger than a quarter)

NO Leggings or jeggings without bottom completely covered by tunic top, shorts, or skirt.

General:

NO Bizarre, extreme, or unusual hairstyles unless approved by administration

NO Open-toed or open-heeled shoes (entire foot must be covered)

NO Wheelie shoes

NO Clothes and accessories that may be disruptive or cause security issues

NO Tears, fraying, holes, or distressed clothing

NO Hair accessories that are distracting or exceed 2" in diameter

NO Exposed undergarments

NO Gauges

NO Chains

NO hats
