

School Grounds Rules and Procedures

Outside rules and procedures for Bonneville Academy focus on ensuring the safety and well-being of students while they are on the school grounds. Here are some standard rules and procedures for the outside areas:

Supervision:

Students must always be supervised by teachers or designated staff members while outside. Teachers and staff are responsible for monitoring student behavior and ensuring safety.

Recess:

Bonneville Academy's outdoor recess offers students valuable physical activity, social interaction, and fresh air opportunities. Students can go outside if the particulate matter is between 35.5 and 55.4 and the temperature is above 22°F. Promoting health and well-being is a cherished part of our school day. Please observe the following guidelines to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience.

- Climbing on top of and jumping off playground equipment is strictly prohibited.
- Do not throw or kick rocks or balls at the school building or over the fence.
- Please refrain from disturbing, tapping, or knocking on classroom windows during recess.
- Physical contact, such as hitting, punching, tackling, or tripping another student, is prohibited.
 - Use of profanity or excessive screaming is not permitted.
 - Wood chips must remain within the playground area.
 - Outside food is only allowed with permission.
 - Listen attentively to aides and teachers and follow instructions promptly.

During inclement weather, indoor recess may be necessary to ensure student safety. Please note the following conditions under which indoor recess will be implemented:

- Temperatures at or below 22°F (Feels Like).
- Hail, heavy rain, current snowfall, lightning, or strong winds.
- Temperatures at or above 95°F.
- The Utah Division of Air Quality reported poor air quality. If particulate matter exceeds 55.5, all students will remain indoors.









Accommodations can be made for students with specific health concerns related to air quality, including asthma, cystic fibrosis, chronic lung disease, congenital heart disease, compromised immune systems, or other respiratory issues. Parents may request indoor recess for their child by contacting the teacher and providing a doctor's note if necessary.

Movement and Behavior:

- Always walk on sidewalks and designated pathways.
- No running, bike riding, or playing in restricted areas (e.g., front sidewalks, parking lots, loading zones).

Games and Activities:

- Organized games must be played in designated areas with permission from teachers or staff.
- Respect school property and equipment; do not climb on fences or buildings.

Line-Up and Dismissal:

- Line up quietly and orderly when transitioning from outside to inside or vice versa.
- · Wait for instructions from teachers or staff during dismissal.

Safety Procedures:

- Follow emergency procedures (fire drills, lockdowns, etc.) as instructed by teachers or staff.
 - Report any safety hazards or concerns to teachers or staff immediately.

Respect for Nature and Environment:

- Treat plants, trees, and shrubs with care and respect.
- Keep outdoor areas clean by disposing of trash in designated bins.

Visitors and Strangers:

- Students should not engage with or follow strangers on or near school grounds.
- Report any unfamiliar individuals to a teacher or staff member immediately.

These rules and procedures are designed to create a safe and structured environment for students during activities and ensure they can enjoy their time while respecting others and school property.
